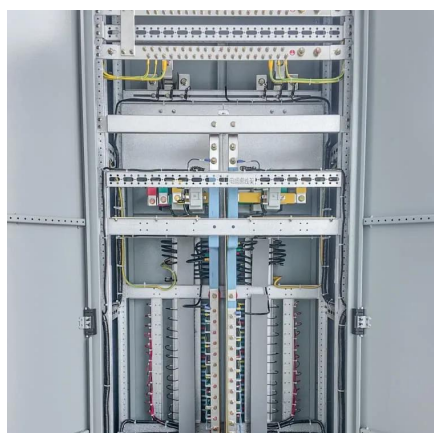

Venezuela has a mixture of state-run and private broadcast media that are subject to high levels of regime control, including the shuttering of opposition-leaning media outlets; 13 public service networks, 61 privately owned TV networks, a privately owned news channel with limited national.

Currently Movistar is the operator with the most installed base stations, with 3,000 sites, followed by Digitel with nearly 2,000. State-run Movilnet, a unit of Cantv, has 1,700 base stations throughout the country, according to Marín. Telecom regulator Conatel's 2023-25 telecommunications plan.

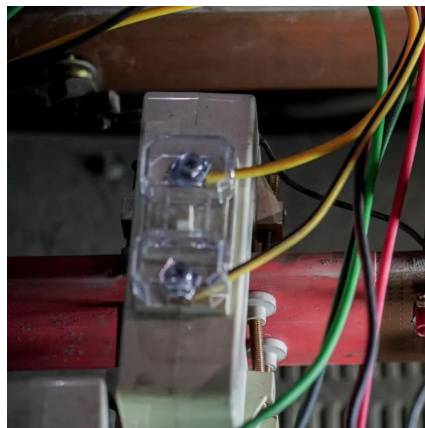

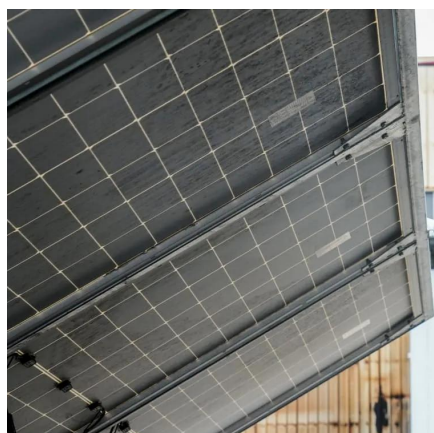
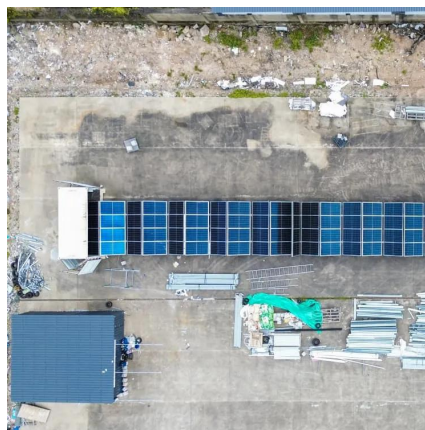
